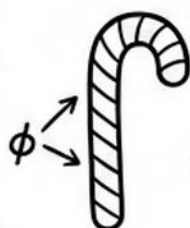


$$T = \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{a(1-y)^2}{2\pi}$$
